## Hancock County District Fair TUFF TRUCK Race Rules

If these rules do not say you can do it, then don't do it!!!

Be sure to check the general rules. All interpretations by the track officials are final. You are responsible to know the track position rules at all times. Ignorance is no excuse!

#### **General Rules:**

- All drivers must wear a helmet with eye protection and a 5-point harness seat belt **AT ALL TIMES**.
- Neck brace is required.
- Long pants, sleeves, and closed toed shoes are required.
- Drivers only allowed in the vehicle- no passengers- no exceptions
- If the driver removes seat belt or helmet or leave the vehicle for any reason during the race (except if your car is on fire or you are authorized by an official). **Immediate disqualification** will result!

#### **ALL RULES SUBJECT TO CHANGE**

#### **Vehicle Requirements:**

- 2-wheel drive, 4-wheel drive, and UTV class. This includes cars, trucks, and suvs. If they have the same drive configuration they will run in the same class.
  - Example: if the vehicle came from the factory with 4wd but it does not work, it will run in the 4wd class, NOT the 2wd class.
- It is required to have window net on drivers door and windshield screen in place to deflect debris.
- All glass, headlights, tail lights, protruding trim, hardware, hub caps must be removed for safety purposes. All loose objects must be removed from vehicle.
- Air bags <u>MUST</u> be unhooked/disabled.
- Only safety modifications are allowed.
  - Roll bars; Redirecting coolant overflow to ground
- No high performance modifications allowed(STOCK ONLY):
  - No lift kits/performance suspension; No high performance engines; no high performance race trucks or suvs/Baja trucks.
- Minor performance enhancements are allowed.
  - o Performance exhaust; Performance intakes.
- Oversize tires or small body lifts will be allowed if the vehicle meets previous requirements.
